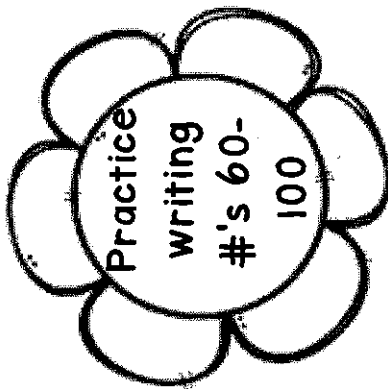
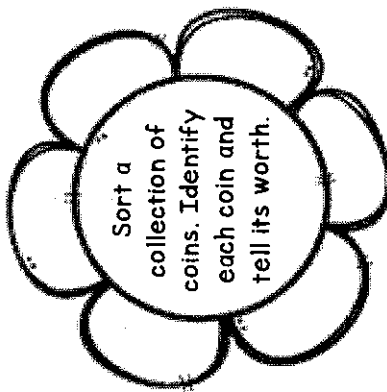
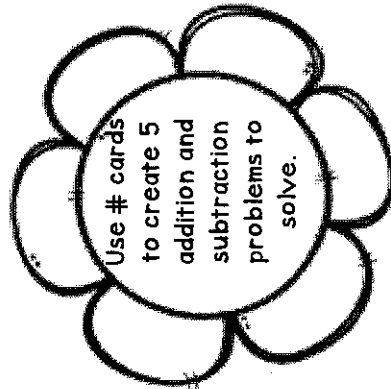
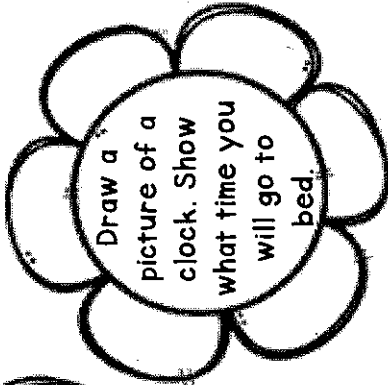
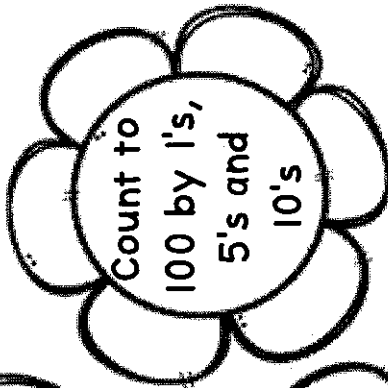
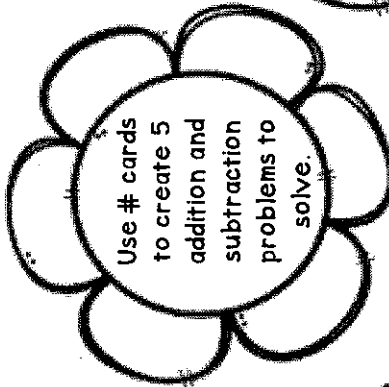
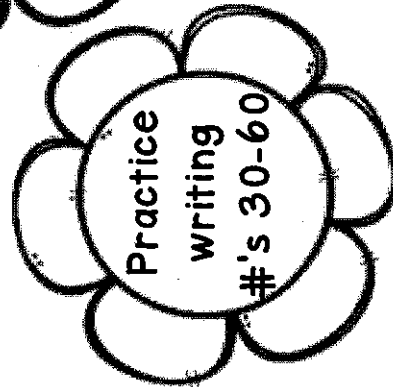
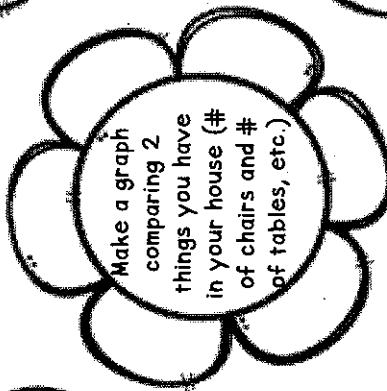
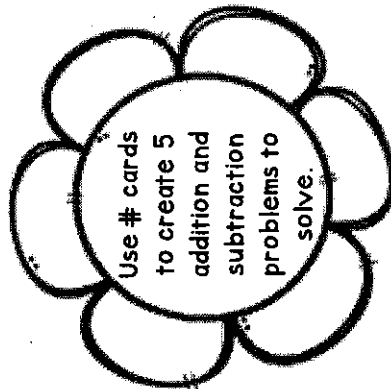
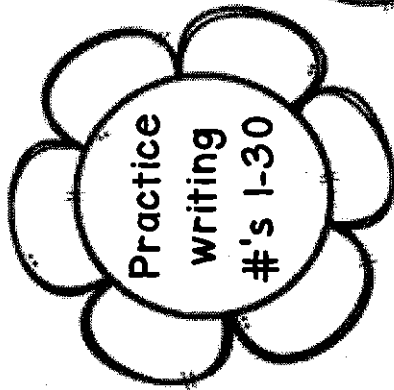
During the summer months, please do the following:

- * Write in your journal at least 3 times. There are extra pages if you'd like to do additional practice!

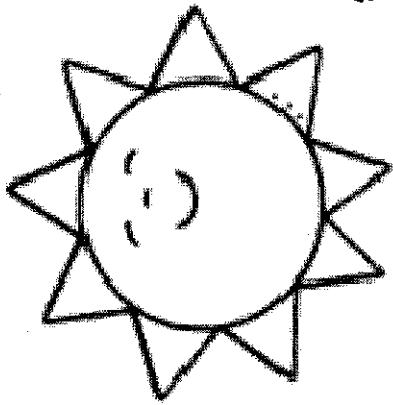
