Thank you for your interest in WSCA. We trust you will schedule a visit to our school. Please feel free to come on any day of the week but, Wednesday, our chapel day, might be your best choice. When to arrive and depart? Plan to arrive by 8:00 AM in the upper school office. You may choose to spend half a day with dismissal at 11:45 AM or a full day with dismissal at 3:00 PM.

Where to report? Report to the upper school office. Go to the upper parking lot in front of the church and follow the signs to the office.

What to wear? Casual, modest, and comfortable clothes are acceptable. Slacks are fine but please no shorts, capris, or jeans. Sneakers are fine but no flip-flops or slippers. Hats and coats are not permitted to be worn in the building.

What to bring? It would be good if you brought a book to read in case a test is being given in a class you are visiting. Cell phones or other electronic devices are not permitted.

What about lunch? You may choose to bring a lunch, or choose from either the hot lunch of the day or salad bar items. School lunch is on WSCA.
